

Edgard Cornachione, Ph.D., is Full Professor at the College of Economics, Business and Accounting of the University of Sao Paulo (USP, Brazil), where he also serves as the Chairman of the Department of Accounting and Actuarial Sciences. Dr. Cornachione is a Brazilian chartered accountant and holds bachelor's, master's and doctoral degrees in Accountancy from USP, where he received the degree of "livre docente" (post doctoral degree). He holds a Ph.D. degree in Human Resource Education from University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign (USA), where he received teaching and academic awards. Dr. Cornachione was appointed the Scientific Director of ANPCONT, Brazil, and member of the Scientific Development Committee of CRC-SP (Brazilian accounting professional body). He has published several studies and books and has a record of successful grant application and funded projects, including, most recently, a grant from the Brazilian Ministry of Education (CAPES) and the US Department of Education (FIPSE) to establish an education consortium between the Brazil (USP & UnB) and US (UIUC & UMN). His currently research interests gravitate around organizational development and human performance improvement by focusing on management education along with its evaluation, including effects of advanced technologies. With solid teaching experience at both undergraduate and graduate levels since 1992 (when he joined the faculty at USP) he has also been involved with in-company training, consulting, and legal opinions. Currently, he serves as editorial board member for journals in Brazil, US, and UK, and as referee for many other journals and conferences (United States, Europe and Brazil). He has been an active member of academic and professional associations such as AAA, IAAER, EAA, AOM, AHRD, ASTD, AERA, CFC, ANPCONT and ANPAD. As a hobby, he exercises his privileges as a private pilot certified by both ANAC (Brazil) and FAA (US).
